Dear Friends,

The Golden Anniversary of the presence of Opus Dei in Canada makes this month of June very special. In the words of a classic hymn, this anniversary is the moment to "count your many blessings, name them one by one. And it will surprise you, what the Lord hath done."

For weeks now we have been coaxing the "old-timers" to tell us once again their stories. Their tales delight us and at the same time fill us with admiration for the marvels that God has done through the generosity of those who started the apostolic work in Canada on June 7, 1957.
