Nevertheless, a vocation could be required if the ecclesial reality itself entailed a specific vocation, which is true in the case of Opus Dei. The Church recognizes and fosters a reality that comes from the Holy Spirit, without whose help the whole prelate of Opus Dei would cease to exist.
