## **THURSDAY, OCTOBER 3**

The mortal remains of Blessed Josemaría will be in the Roman Basilica of St. Eugene for veneration by the faithful from October 3 to

October 9. The Basilica is at n.10, Via delle Belle Arti.

There will also be an exhibition about the life of the new saint in the cortile of the Basilica on these dates.

**FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4 9:00 p.m.**

10:00 a.m. Holy Mass of thanksgiving for the canonization of Josemaría Escrivá in St. Peter's Square,

celebrated by Bishop Javier Echevarría, Opus Dei's Prelate, and concelebrated by Opus Dei's various regional vicars.

**11:30 a.m.** Audience with His Holiness John Paul II

**TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY,  
OCTOBER 8 &9**

In the days after the canonization, various cardinals and bishops will be celebrating Masses of thanksgiving in Roman churches, in 15 languages.
