Saint Josemaría Escrivá often expressed his affection and gratitude for the family in which he was born in the Aragonese city of Barbastro, Spain. “God our Lord disposed things in such a way that my early life was quite normal and ordinary and in no way exceptional. He caused me to be born into a Catholic family, like most people in my country, with exemplary parents who practised their faith in daily life” (Saint Josemaría Escrivá, 14 February 1964).

“The pure and noble love of spouses is something holy which I, as a priest, bless with both hands. [...] Our Lord sanctifies and blesses the husband’s love for his wife and the wife’s for her husband” (Saint Josemaría Escrivá, *Christ is Passing By*, 24).
