Upon graduation, Fr Silvano worked at Otieno Odongo & Partners
Consulting Engineers before proceeding to Rome in 1994 for further studies. In Rome he earned a Masters Degree and later, in 2001, a PhD in Moral Theology from the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross. He was ordained a priest for the Prelature of Opus Dei in 1998.

Fr Silvano returned to Kenya in January 2001, and since then he has devoted himself fully to the priestly care of thousands of people, young and old, in different undertakings of the Prelature. He has also been collaborating closely with the Prelate's Council in East Africa.
