Pilgrims preparing their trip to Rome and all those interested in the celebrations to take place around Oct. 6 will be able to find useful, upto-date information in Italian, Spanish, English and French, under the following headings:

## The Canonization: offers a

provisional program of the celebrations that will take place from Oct. 3 to Oct. 10, as well as information about the Masses of thanksgiving that will be said in different languages; it also indicates places where one can pray before the relics of the new saint.

How to attend: pilgrims who wish to attend the canonization of Blessed Josemaría can find in this section the leads of the organizing committees of each country, who are preparing, in coordination with the committee of Rome, everything that has to do with travel, lodging, etc. Information is also provided about tickets to the ceremony, places to eat, and information centers that will be set up in central locations of Rome during these days.
