The *Discover Saint Josemaria* conference is a virtual event organized by people who have taken the message of the saint to heart and are trying to live it in their day-to-day lives of work and family concerns.

This year the conference will explore deep friendship as life's gift and a grace from God. We will share practical ways of developing friendship in the family following the teachings of St. Josemaría Escrivá.

The conference will focus on these 3 areas:

1. Friendship in the Family: We would focus on how to build and maintain friendship in the family and how friendship aids family development with its consequences and significance among siblings and with parents.

2. Friendship and Christianizing Society: This topic would focus on how friendship unlocks some of the core questions that currently affect families and society at large. Could Friendship be the key to more holiness in society?

3. Deep Friendship: We will explore the true nature of friendship and share how each one can grow in their capacity for deep friendship with God and others with practical examples from the life of St. Josemaría.
