With God's help and the evenings of recollections organized by women of Opus Dei in Oslo, I was able to bear everything calmly. I learned to abandon my life in God's hands and to smile, and I encouraged the others who had also lost their jobs, telling them that life was not over for them.

One night, during the time I was out of work, I decided to open the Opus Dei website at home and read through people's testimonies of how St. Josemaria Escriva had helped them in their work situations. I was overwhelmed by all the letters. I

wondered if the same miracle could happen to me. I looked at Josemaria's face on the computer screen and asked him if he would help me too even if he didn't know me.
