The <u>"News"</u> section has some financial data about the Prelature for 2022 as well as news about an event honoring Venerable Isidoro Zorzano in Malaga.

The main article in the <u>"Initiatives"</u> section is entitled <u>"Midwife Training</u> to Reduce Infant Mortality in Congo."

Finally, the Study that closes this issue of *Romana*, written by Professor Carla Rossi Espagnet, from the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross, has the title <u>"Specific Features</u> of Marital Spirituality."
