

"Passionately Loving the World": 50th Anniversary

On October 8, 1967, Saint Josemaria gave a homily at an outdoor Mass on the campus of the University of Navarra that contains the core of his message on sanctifying daily life.

October 8, 1967. For the first time an outdoor Mass was celebrated in the recently begun University of Navarra. After the reading of the

Gospel, Josemaría Escrivá vigorously grasped in his hands several pages, walked slowly to the microphone and (quite unusual for him, since he liked to preach personally to his listeners) read his homily. He wanted to follow the written text closely, words that had been carefully worked and shaped, almost sculpted. His firmly voiced words reached the hearts of many people. Fifty years later they continue to inspire men and women all over the world, encouraging them to seek God in all daily realities.
