Yesterday the new card arrived, identical to the last one except, for no apparent reason other than that Dora was helping me, the credit limit had been raised. This seemed to me to be a miracle, because now I had the money to pay for what was necessary.

The loan did not come through, but the situation was no longer dire. I want to thank Dora for this favor. I received the most important thing that I had asked for, which was to be able to pay for our rent, our food, and the salary of our maid, among other things. Thanks so much, and I will pray more, but now I will pray that Dora's life be better known. Blessings.
