The kits are free and donations are encouraged. They can be ordered online at the *St. Josemaria Institute* or by calling 877-785-6736 (toll-free). The parts of the Mass can also be downloaded from the site in English and Spanish. Orders must be

received before June 10 (orders from outside the US should be placed before June 5).

The St. Josemaria Institute was founded to spread the teachings and spirituality of St. Josemaria Escriva, who was declared a saint in 2002 by Pope John Paul II.
