This volume contains the first four *Letters* of some 38 of a foundational nature which St Josemaría Escrivá wrote. Although they are addressed to all members of Opus Dei, they are valuable resources for everyone in the Church.

Letter 1, dated 24 March 1930, is on the call to holiness and apostolate in ordinary life.

Letter 2, dated 24 March 1931, highlights the importance of humility in one's spiritual life.

Letter 3, dated 9 January 1932, deals with the supernatural and apostolic

mission of the members of Opus Dei in the middle of the world.

Letter 4, dated 16 July 1933, explains the way of proclaiming Christian doctrine through personal apostolate.
