Just as Christ “went about doing good” [1] throughout Palestine, so must you also spread peace in your family circle, in civil society, on the job, and in your cultural and leisure activities. This will be the best proof that the kingdom of God has reached your heart. As St John wrote: “We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the

brethren" [2]. (Christ is passing by, 166)
