Archbishop-elect Gomez will succeed

Antonio since 1979.

Prior to his appointment as Auxiliary
Bishop of Denver in 2001,
Archbishop-elect Gomez had been
the Vicar of the Delegation of Texas
for the Prelature of Opus Dei.
