The March, whose mission is to end abortion by uniting, educating, and mobilizing pro-life people in the public square, starts on the National Mall and ends at the Supreme Court building. Oakcrest, located in Vienna, VA, has a long tradition of supporting the March for Life. Each year, the school closes on the day of the March so that students, faculty, and staff can all attend with their families. The Oakcrest School delegation is led by the student-run Respect Life Club, which carries the Oakcrest banner.

says Oakcrest Head of School Dr. Mary T. Ortiz.
